A record review conducted on 11/10/2020 of Resident #10's health assessment (1823) dated 11/10/2020, reveals no significant changes and no weight or meal intake monitoring. Special Precautions are marked as "None" on the 1823. A record review for Resident #10 conducted on 11/10/2020 reveals a physician's order dated 11/10/2020 to encourage PO (by 11/10/2020) intake due to "++ loss." A review of Resident #10's annual wellness physical dated 11/10/2020 reveals a 11/10/2020 and 2 ounces with clothing on. The documentation reveals a 11/10/2020 onset (difficulty swallowing) on 11/10/2020, onset date of 11/10/2020, and a subsequent 11/10/2020 loss onset date of 11/10/2020. The physician documents "nearly 30- 11/10/2020 loss and that the resident reports very poor PO (by 11/10/2020) intake. The Physician requests the facility encourage PO (by 11/10/2020) intake and for the resident to be 11/10/2020 regularly. The contact with the health care provider must also be documented in the resident's record. (c) Medication administration includes conducting any examination or other procedure necessary for the proper administration of medication that the resident cannot conduct personally and that can be performed by licensed staff. (d) A facility that performs clinical laboratory tests for residents, including _____ testing, must be in compliance with the federal Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 (CLIA) and chapter 483, part I, F.S. A valid copy of the State Clinical Laboratory License, if required, and the federal CLIA Certificate must be maintained in the facility.
