The preservice orientation must be at least 2 hours in duration and cover topics that help the employee provide responsible care and respond to the needs of facility residents. Upon completion, the employee and the administrator of the facility must sign a statement that the employee completed the required preservice orientation. The facility must keep the signed statement in the employee's personnel record. (7) Facility staff shall participate in inservice training relevant to their job duties as specified by agency rule. Topics covered during the preservice orientation are not required to be repeated during inservice training. A single certificate of completion that covers all required inservice training topics may be issued to a participating staff member if the training is provided in a single training course. 59A-36.011 (2) STAFF PRESERVICE ORIENTATION. (d) In addition to topics that may be chosen by the facility administrator, the preservice orientation must cover: 1. Resident's rights; and, 2. The facility's license type and services offered by the facility. (3) STAFF IN-SERVICE TRAINING. Facility administrators or managers shall provide or arrange for the following in-service training to facility staff: (a) Staff who provide direct care to residents, other than nurses, certified nursing assistants, or home health aides trained in accordance with rule 59A-8.0095, F.A.C., must receive a minimum of 1 hour in-service training in _____ control, including universal precautions and facility sanitation procedures, before providing personal care to residents. Resident rights in an assisted living facility. 2. Recognizing and reporting resident neglect, and The facility must use its prevention policies and procedures when offering this training. (d) Staff who provide direct care to residents, other than nurses, CNAs, or home health aides trained in accordance with rule 59A-8.0095, F.A.C., must receive 3 hours of in-service training within 30 days of employment that covers the following subjects: 1. Resident behavior and needs. 2. Providing assistance with the activities of daily living. (e) Staff who prepare or serve food, who have not taken the assisted living facility core training must receive a minimum of 1-hour-in-service training within 30 days of employment in safe food handling practices. (f) All facility staff shall receive in-service training regarding the facility's resident elopement response policies and procedures within thirty (30) days of employment. 1. All facility staff shall be provided with a copy of the facility's resident elopement response policies and procedures. 2. 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A 081	Continued From page 3 This Statute or Rule is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review and an interview, the facility failed to ensure 3 out of 3 sampled staff, Staff A, Staff B and Staff C, had completed 2 hours of Preservice Orientation with a certificate showing completion signed by the Administrator and the staff member prior to interacting with residents; and, failed to ensure that 1 out of 3 sampled staff, Staff C who provides direct care to residents had received the required in-service training within 30 days of employment. The findings included: A. Review of the personnel files for Staff A, Staff B and Staff C, who work as caregivers for residents, revealed no certificates of a 2 hour Pre-Service Orientation, including training in Residents' Rights and ALF (Assisted Living facility) services, signed by both the Administrator and the employee. B. Review of the personnel file for Staff C, who provides direct care to residents, revealed there was no documentation of the following required in-service training dated within 30 days of employment. Staff C was hired on 1. Facility's Emergency Procedures and Incident Reporting (1 hour required) 2. Residents' Rights (part of 1 hour required) The Business Office Manager was interviewed at 11:00 AM on _____ and confirmed that the aforementioned documentation was not present and available for review.
