This training and education is intended to assist facilities to appropriately respond to the needs of residents, to maintain resident care and facility standards, and to meet licensure requirements. (3) The agency, in conjunction with providers, shall develop core training requirements for administrators consisting of core training learning objectives, a competency test, and a minimum required score to indicate successful passage of the core competency test. The required core competency test must cover at least the following topics: (a) State law and rules relating to assisted living facilities. (b) Resident rights and identifying and reporting neglect, and (c) Special needs of elderly persons, persons with mental illness, and persons with and how to meet those needs. (d) Nutrition and food service, including acceptable sanitation practices for preparing, storing, and serving food. (g) Care of persons with _____'s _____ and related _____ 59A-36.011 (1) ASSISTED LIVING FACILITY CORE TRAINING REQUIREMENTS AND COMPETENCY TEST. (a) The assisted living facility core training requirements established by the department pursuant to section 429.52, F.S., shall consist of a minimum of 26 hours of training plus a competency test. (b) Administrators and managers must successfully complete the assisted living facility core training requirements within 3 months from the date of becoming a facility administrator or manager. Successful completion of the core training requirements includes passing the competency test. The minimum passing score for the competency test is 75%. Administrators who have attended core training prior to _____, and managers who attended the core training program prior to _____, shall not be required to take the competency test. Administrators licensed as nursing home administrators in accordance with chapter 468, part II, F.S., are exempt from this requirement. (c) Administrators and managers shall participate in 12 hours of continuing education in topics related to assisted living every 2 years. (d) A newly hired administrator or manager who has successfully completed the assisted living facility core training and continuing education requirements, shall not be required to retake the core training. An administrator or manager who has successfully completed the core training but has not maintained the continuing education	A 080		

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A 080	Continued From page 2 requirements will be considered a new administrator or manager for the purposes of the core training requirements and must: 1. Retake the assisted living facility core training; and, 2. Retake and pass the competency test. (e) The fees for the competency test shall not exceed \$200.00. The payment for the competency test fee shall be remitted to the entity administering the test. A new fee is due each time the test is taken. This Statute or Rule is not met as evidenced by: Based on personnel record review and interview, the facility had no documentation to confirm that the administrator had participated in 12 hours of continuing education in topics related to assisted living every 2 years. 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A 084	Continued From page 3 SELF-ADMINISTRATION OF MEDICATION AND MEDICATION MANAGEMENT. Unlicensed persons who will be providing assistance with the self-administration of medications as described in rule 59A-36.008, F.A.C., must meet the training requirements pursuant to section 429.52(6), F.S., prior to assuming this responsibility. Courses provided in fulfillment of this requirement must meet the following criteria: (a) Training must cover state law and rule requirements with respect to the supervision, assistance, administration, and management of medications in assisted living facilities; procedures and techniques for assisting the resident with self-administration of medication including how to read a prescription label; providing the right medications to the right resident; common medications; the importance of taking medications as prescribed; recognition of side effects and adverse reactions and procedures to follow when residents appear to be experiencing side effects and adverse reactions; documentation and record keeping; and medication storage and disposal. Training shall include demonstrations of proper techniques, including techniques for control, and ensure unlicensed staff have adequately demonstrated that they have acquired the skills necessary to provide such assistance. (b) The training must be provided by a registered nurse or licensed pharmacist who shall issue a training certificate to a trainee who demonstrates, in person and both physically and verbally, the ability to: 1. Read and understand a prescription label; 2. Provide assistance with self-administration in accordance with section 429.256, F.S., and rule 59A-36.008, F.A.C., including: a. Assist with oral dosage forms, ... dosage	A 084

Measure liquid medications, break scored tablets, and crush tablets in accordance with prescription directions; c. Recognize the need to obtain clarification of an "as needed" prescription order; d. Recognize a medication order which requires judgment or discretion, and to advise the resident, resident's health care provider or facility employer of inability to assist in the administration of such orders; e. Complete a medication observation record; f. Retrieve and store medication; g. Recognize the general signs of adverse reactions to medications and report such reactions; h. Assist residents with _____ syringes that are prefilled with the proper dosage by a pharmacist and _____ that are prefilled by the manufacturer by taking the medication, in its previously dispensed, properly labeled container, from where it is stored, and bringing it to the resident for self-injection; i. Assist with _____; j. Use a _____ to perform _____ testing; k. Assist residents with _____ and continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) devices, excluding the titration of the _____ levels; l. 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A 084	Continued From page 5 429.256(1)(b), F.S., who provide assistance with self-administered medications and have successfully completed the initial 6 hour training, must obtain, annually, a minimum of 2 hours of continuing education training on providing assistance with self-administered medications and safe medication practices in an assisted living facility. The 2 hours of continuing education training may be provided online. (d) Trained unlicensed staff who, prior to the effective date of this rule, assist with the self-administration of medication and have successfully completed 4 hours of assistance with self-administration of medication training must complete an additional 2 hours of training that focuses on the topics listed in sub-subparagraphs (6)(b)2.h.-n. of this section, before assisting with the self-administration of medication procedures listed in sub-subparagraphs (6)(b)2.h.-n. 429.52 (6) Staff assisting with the self-administration of medications under s. 429.256 must complete a minimum of 6 additional hours of training provided by a registered nurse or a licensed pharmacist before providing assistance. Two hours of continuing education are required annually thereafter. 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A 084	Continued From page 6 Assisted Living Facility (ALF) provided by a licensed registered nurse, or a licensed pharmacist. Findings: 1. On at 9:45 AM, the administrator (staff A) was observed providing assistance with resident #6's medication. Personnel record review for the administrator revealed there was a certificate for a 6-hour medication training. Further review of the certificate revealed the signature of the trainer was not the original signature, it was copied. The name of the administrator and the date was an original handwritten signature. The date of the training was (future date). 2. Personnel record review for staff B, a caregiver, hired, on at 10:50 AM, she said she provided assistance with the resident's medication. Personnel record review revealed the only evidence of the medication trainings for staff B was a 6-hour medication training certificate dated, the signature of the trainer was not the original signature, it was copied. The name of staff B and the date was original handwriting. There was another certificate for the 6-hour medication training that did not have a name of the person who received the training. The space for the name of the trainee was blank, the signature of the trainer was not the original signature, it was copied. The date of the training was (future date). 3. On at 12:30 PM the administrator said staff C assisted the residents with their medications.	A 084		

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A 084	Continued From page 7 Personnel record review for staff C, a caregiver hired _____, revealed the only evidence found for the 6-hour medication training was dated _____, the signature of the trainer was not the original signature, it was copied. The name of staff C and the date was original handwriting. Because the signature of the trainer was copied and the administrator and staff B's certificates were for future dates, there was no evidence to confirm that the staff actually received the training.
