(b) Unusual reactions to the medication or a significant change in the resident's health or behavior that may be caused by the medication must be documented in the resident's record and reported immediately to the resident's health care provider. The contact with the health care provider must also be documented in the resident's record. (c) Medication administration includes conducting any examination or other procedure necessary for the proper administration of medication that the resident cannot conduct personally and that can be performed by licensed staff. (d) A facility that performs clinical laboratory tests for residents, including _____ testing, must be in compliance with the federal Clinical Laboratory Improvement Amendments of 1988 (CLIA) and Chapter 483, Part I, F.S. A valid copy of the federal CLIA Certificate must be maintained in the facility. This Statute or Rule is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review and interview the facility failed to have a staff member licensed to administer medications to one out of three sampled residents (# 1). Findings included: On at 7:33 AM Staff C (caregiver) stated that Residents # 1 and # 2 were receiving hospice services and Resident # 2 was under the care of a hospice that sent a nurse every day to give her the medications and stated that for Resident # 1 they (facility staff) gave the medications. On at 7:38 AM Staff B (caregiver) stated that Resident # 1 needed total assistance, but she was able to take the medications with assistance and a lot of difficulty and that they gave her the medications crushed. At 7:43 AM he stated that the resident's daughter and a nurse were giving the medications to her. Review of the medication observation record revealed that the medications for Resident # 1 were being signed off by the facility's staff. Review of residents' records revealed that Resident # 1 was receiving hospice services since with a diagnosis of Degenerative of the Nervous System, Unspecified. A prescription for puree diet and crush medications was dated . On at 8:10 AM Staff D stated, "We do not have a nurse yet, we are in the process of getting one. We are giving her the medications when the daughter does not come." On at 8:19 AM Staff A (caregiver) stated, "I am not going to lie to you. The daughter came 2 or 3 times and that's it, we are giving her the medications because that hospice does not provide the services. I have been trying to get a nurse to come and it is difficult. We have a resident that is receiving home health and I am going to talk to the nurse to see if he wants to be , because anyway, he comes twice a day for the other resident.
