(a) For residents who use a pill organizer managed in subsection (2), the facility must keep either the original labeled medication container; or a medication listing with the prescription number, the name and address of the issuing pharmacy, the health care provider's name, the resident's name, the date dispensed, the name and strength of the drug, and the directions for use. (b) The facility must maintain a daily medication observation record for each resident who receives assistance with self-administration of medications or medication administration. A medication observation record must be immediately updated each time the medication is offered or administered and include: 1. The name of the resident and any known . . . the resident may have; 2. The name of the resident's health care provider and the health care provider's telephone number; 3. The name, strength, and directions for use of each medication; and, 4. A chart for recording each time the medication is taken, any missed dosages, refusals to take medication as prescribed, or medication errors. (c) For medications that serve as chemical . . . , the facility must, pursuant to Section 429.41, F.S., maintain a record of the prescribing physician's annual evaluation of the use of the medication. 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A 054	Continued From page 1 This Statute or Rule is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review and interview, the facility failed to maintain daily Medication Observation Records (MORs) accurately when medications were not given to one (Resident #4) of two sampled residents. Findings included: A record review of the MORs for Resident #4, revealed 10milligrams was not documented as given to the resident and there were no comment code or staff initials. In an interview with the Administrative Assistant conducted on at 2:38pm, they agreed that there should be a code or initials that corresponded if the medication was given or missed.
