Staff A did not have the medication observation records open and was not able to check the medication labels against the medication observation records. Staff A did not orally advise the resident the names and doses of the medications that he was receiving. During an interview with Staff A, conducted on at 11:03 AM, Staff A stated the medications given were Resident #9's 8:00 AM medications. A record review for Resident #9, conducted on , revealed that 325mg, 25mg, 20mg, and D 2000mg were all due at 8:00 AM. During an observation of the medication pass with Staff A for Resident #8, conducted on at 11:05 AM, revealed Staff A assisted the resident with 25/100mg. Staff A stated "I am going to give you your 12:00 PM medication" and gave Resident #8 the medications. Staff A did not orally advise the name and dose of the medication. During an observation of the medication pass with Staff A for Resident #7, conducted on at 11:12 AM, revealed Staff A assisted the resident with 50mg. The preservice orientation must be at least 2 hours in duration and cover topics that help the employee provide responsible care and respond to the needs of facility residents. Upon completion, the employee and the administrator of the facility must sign a statement that the employee completed the required preservice orientation. The facility must keep the signed statement in the employee's personnel record. (b) Each assisted living facility employee must complete the training required under s. 430.5025. However, an employee of an assisted living facility licensed as a limited mental health facility under s. 429.075 is exempt from the training requirements under s. 430.5025(4)(d). (c) If an assisted living facility employee completes the 1-hour training required under s. 430.5025 before interacting with residents, such training may count toward the 2 hours of preservice orientation required under paragraph (a).
