A 165	429.23(&) FS Risk Mgmt & QA 429.23 Internal risk management and quality assurance program; adverse incidents and reporting requirements. - (1) Every facility licensed under this part may, as part of its administrative functions, voluntarily establish a risk management and quality assurance program, the purpose of which is to assess resident care practices, facility incident reports, deficiencies cited by the agency, adverse incident reports, and resident grievances and develop plans of action to correct and respond quickly to identify quality differences. (2) Every facility licensed under this part is required to maintain adverse incident reports. For purposes of this section, the term, "adverse incident" means: (a) An event over which facility personnel could exercise control rather than as a result of the resident's condition and results in: 1. ; 2. or damage; 3. Permanent ; 4. or of bones or joints; 5. Any condition that required medical attention to which the resident has not given his or her consent, including failure to honor advanced directives; 6. An event that is reported to law enforcement or its personnel for investigation; or (b) Resident elopement, if the elopement places the resident at risk of harm or injury. (3) Licensed facilities shall provide within 1 business day after the occurrence of an adverse incident, through the agency's online portal, or if the portal is offline, by electronic mail, a preliminary report to the agency on all adverse incidents specified under this section. The report must include information regarding the identity of the affected resident, the type of adverse incident, and the status of the facility's investigation of the incident. (4) Licensed facilities shall provide within 15 days, through the agency's online portal, or if the portal is offline, by electronic mail, a full report to the agency on all adverse incidents specified in this section. The report must include the results of the facility's investigation into the adverse incident. (6) . . . , neglect, or . . . must be reported to the Department of Children and Families as required under chapter 415. (7) The information reported to the agency pursuant to subsection (3) which relates to persons licensed under chapter 458, chapter 459, chapter 461, chapter 464, or chapter 465 shall be reviewed by the agency. The agency shall determine whether any of the incidents potentially involved conduct by a health care professional who is subject to disciplinary action, in which case the provisions of s. 456.073 apply. The agency may investigate, as it deems appropriate, any such incident and prescribe measures that must or may be taken in response to the incident. (8) If the agency, through its receipt of the adverse incident reports prescribed in this part or through any investigation, has reasonable belief that conduct by a staff member or employee of a licensed facility is grounds for disciplinary action by the appropriate board, the agency shall report this fact to such regulatory board. (9) The adverse incident reports and preliminary adverse incident reports required under this section are confidential as provided by law and are not discoverable or admissible in any civil or administrative action, except in disciplinary proceedings by the agency or appropriate regulatory board. (10) The agency may adopt rules necessary to administer this section. This Statute or Rule is not met as evidenced by: Based on record review and interview, the facility failed to submit an Adverse Incident Report to the Agency for Healthcare Administration for 2 of 3 sampled residents (Resident #3 and Resident #4) who were involved in a physical altercation incident reported to law enforcement for investigation. Findings include: Review of Resident #4's record revealed a progress note that read, "Resident had altercation w/ [sic] [Resident #3's name] no injuries report, refused. MD aware." Resident became irate, chased Med Tech (Medication Technician) out of building. [Med Tech's name] tried to close door. [Resident #3's name] kicked in front of door and proceeded to grab [Resident #4's name] out of his wheelchair onto the floor and assaulted resident. 911 was already on their way. Police arrived and saw [Resident #3's name] being agitated and aggressive at which time he was taken by police and Review of the facility's Hospital Log revealed that on , Resident #3 was transported to "jail" for "assault," and transported by 911 with no return date. During an interview on at 3:15 PM, the Assistant Executive Director stated, "I don't report to AHCA. I let corporate know, we start our investigation, and they determine if an incident needs to be reported to AHCA. I didn't know that calling law enforcement needed to be reported to AHCA. What happened between [Resident #3's name and Resident #4's name] was , , assault against another resident."
