For purposes of this subsection, the term OTC includes, but is not limited to, OTC medications, , nutritional supplements and nutraceuticals, hereafter referred to as OTC products, which can be sold without a prescription. (a) A stock supply of OTC products for multiple resident use is not permitted in any facility. (b) OTC products, including those prescribed by a licensed health care provider, must be labeled with the resident ' s name and the manufacturer ' s label with directions for use, or the licensed health care provider ' s directions for use. No other labeling requirements are necessary nor should be required. (c) Residents or their representatives may purchase OTC products from an establishment of their choice. (d) A facility cannot require a licensed health care provider ' s order for all OTC products when a resident self-administers his or her own medications, or when staff provides assistance with self-administration of medications pursuant to Section 429.256, F.S. A licensed health care provider ' s order is required when a licensed nurse provides assistance with self-administration or administration of medications, which includes OTC products. When such an order for an OTC product exists, only the requirements of paragraphs (b) and (c) of this subsection are required.	A 057
