A MOR must include the name of the resident and any known the resident may have; the name of the resident ' s health care provider, the health care provider ' s telephone number; the name, strength, and directions for use of each medication; and a chart for recording each time the medication is taken, any missed dosages, refusals to take medication as prescribed, or medication errors. The MOR must be immediately updated each time the medication is offered or administered. (c) For medications which serve as chemical , the facility shall, pursuant to Section 429.41, F.S., maintain a record of the prescribing physician ' s annual evaluation of the use of the medication. (b) All staff shall be assigned duties consistent with his/her level of education, training, preparation, and experience. (a) Pursuant to Section 429.075, F.S., the administrator, managers and staff, who have direct contact with mental health residents in a licensed limited mental health facility, must receive the following training: 1. A minimum of 6 hours of specialized training in working with individuals with mental health diagnoses. a. The training must be provided or approved by the Department of Children and Families and must be taken within 6 months of the facility's receiving a limited mental health license or within 6 months of employment in a limited mental health facility. b. For administrators and managers, the continuing education requirement under this subsection will satisfy 3 of the 12 hours of continuing education required biennially pursuant to Section 429.52(4), F.S., and subsection (1) of this rule. 4.
