(2) Every facility licensed under this part is required to maintain adverse incident reports. (3) Licensed facilities shall provide within 1 business day after the occurrence of an adverse incident, by electronic mail, facsimile, or United States mail, a preliminary report to the agency on all adverse incidents specified under this section. The report must include information regarding the identity of the affected resident, the type of adverse incident, and the status of the facility ' s investigation of the incident. (4) Licensed facilities shall provide within 15 days, by electronic mail, facsimile, or United States mail, a full report to the agency on all adverse incidents specified in this section. The report must include the results of the facility ' s investigation into the adverse incident. 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A 165	Continued From page 2 (8) If the agency, through its receipt of the adverse incident reports prescribed in this part or through any investigation, has reasonable belief that conduct by a staff member or employee of a licensed facility is grounds for disciplinary action by the appropriate board, the agency shall report this fact to such regulatory board. (9) The adverse incident reports and preliminary adverse incident reports required under this section are confidential as provided by law and are not discoverable or admissible in any civil or administrative action, except in disciplinary proceedings by the agency or appropriate regulatory board. (10) The Department of Elderly Affairs may adopt rules necessary to administer this section. Adverse Incident Report. (1) INITIAL ADVERSE INCIDENT REPORT. The preliminary adverse incident report required by Section 429.23(3), F.S., must be submitted within one (1) business day after the incident on AHCA Form 3180-1024, Assisted Living Facility Initial Adverse Incident Report-1 Day, 2006, and incorporated by reference. Findings include: On _____ an interview was conducted with the administrator about 8:15 AM. The administrator stated resident #1 was admitted to the facility on _____ and he recognized the resident was going through sundowners and getting antsy. The administrator stated that on _____, 2012 at approximately 5:00 PM, resident #1 kept talking about she wanted to go visit a friend that doesn't live in the neighborhood. He stated Staff Member A looked in the back of facility and didn't see resident #1, then she called 911. Resident #1 was found out front of the facility on the dirt road while staff member A was on the call with 911. The administrator confirmed he did not report an Adverse Incident report because staff member A	A 165

He stated the resident really didn't get away because she was found in the process of the police showing up. On during a further interview with staff member A about 8:30 AM, she stated she contacted the Bay County Sheriff Office after supper time and the officer evaluated resident #1 by asking her questions such as year and location. She stated the resident thought she was in North Carolina and did not know the year. Staff member A stated the officer advised he was going to take resident #1 to a behavioral hospital. 4) A review of the Computer Aid Dispatch report revealed a call was made to the Bay County Sheriff Office on at 20:03 regarding "a female left the facility and returned and in the living. The caller was afraid resident may try to leave again and felt she needed to go to a behavioral hospital since the Assisted Living Facility does not have a lock down unit.
