Until such written notice is received, the agreed upon daily, weekly, or monthly rate may be charged by the facility unless the resident ' s medical condition, such as the resident ' s being comatose, prevents the resident from giving written notification and the resident does not have a responsible party to act in the resident ' s behalf. (i) A provision stating whether the organization is affiliated with any religious organization, and, if so, which organization and its relationship to the facility. (j) A provision that, upon determination by the administrator or health care provider that the resident needs services beyond those the facility is licensed to provide, the resident or the resident ' s representative, or agency acting on the resident ' s behalf, shall be notified in writing that the resident must make arrangements for transfer to a care setting that has services needed by the resident. In the event the resident has no person to represent him, the facility shall refer the resident to the social service agency for placement. If there is disagreement regarding the appropriateness of placement, provisions as outlined in Section 429.26(8), F.S., shall take effect.
