The bars within the bed rails should be closely spaced to prevent a patient's head from passing through the opening and becoming entrapped. The mattress to bed rail interface should prevent an individual from falling between the mattress and bed rails and possibly smothering. Care should be taken that the mattress does not shrink over time or after cleaning. Such shrinkage increases the potential space between the rails and the mattress. Check for compression of the mattresses outside perimeter. Easily compressed perimeters can increase the gaps between the mattress and the bed rail.
