This letter reports the findings of a complaint survey (CCR#2013010095) and a biennial re-licensure inspection survey conducted on October 9, 2013, by representatives of the Agency for Health Care Administration (Agency). Attached is the provider's copy of the Statement of Deficiencies, which indicates there were deficiencies noted during the inspection. You are hereby responsible for complying with the Agency's Directed Plan of Correction (DPOC) within **ten business days** of receipt of this report.

The inspection resulted in findings of non-compliance in the following areas:

St - A - 0078 - 58a-5.019(2) Fac - Staffing Standards - Staff S-S= D
St - A - 0083 - 58a-5.0191(4) Fac - Training - First Aid and Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR)
S-S= G

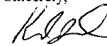
Directed Corrective Actions:

1. The Assisted Living Facility is required to train all night shift staff in Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and First Aid.
2. The Assisted Living Facility is required to develop a process for ensuring that at least one staff member with training in CPR and First Aid is on duty at all times.

Please be advised that nothing in this DPOC limits the Agency's authority and responsibility to impose administrative sanctions as provided by law.
