The findings are: In an observation on _____ at 11:35am, inside resident #1's _____, there was a pill organizer container which had several oral medications inside of it on top of the dining _____. In an interview with resident #1 on _____ at 11:40am, she stated that she self-administered all of her medications daily and did not receive assistance from the facility staff with her medications. In an interview with the facility's nursing supervisor on _____ at 11:45am, she stated that the facility did not presently assist resident #1 with self-administration of her medications and she was not aware if the resident received a physician's order for self-administration of her medications. Review of resident #1's health assessment dated on _____ indicated that the resident was diagnosed with _____, memory _____ and _____. Review of this health assessment indicated that the resident presently received 7 different oral medications and the physician ordered that the resident needed to receive daily assistance with self-administration of medications. Further review of the resident's record indicated and there were no other physician's orders for the resident to receive any other type of assistance with her medications. In an interview with the nursing supervisor on _____ at 12:10pm, she stated that resident #1 did not have any physician's orders for the resident to self-administer her own medications. Class III
