0000 - Initial Comments An unannounced Extended Congregate Care monitor survey was conducted at Pacifica Senior Living, an assisted living facility (license #9346) in Fort Myers, Florida. The following is description of the deficiency. E210 - ECC - Training - 58A-5.0191(7) FAC Based on record review and interview, the facility failed to ensure all direct care staff providing care to residents in an Extended Congregate Care (ECC) program complete at least 2 hours of in-service training within 6 months of beginning employment in the facility for 3 (Staff A, B, and C) of 3 staff reviewed. The findings included: Staff A was hired as a Licensed Practical Nurse on . Staff A's personnel file contained no documentation of receiving 2 hours of ECC in-service training. Staff B was hired as a Personal Care Aide () on . Staff B's personnel file contained no documentation of receiving 2 hours of ECC in-service training. Staff C was hired as a on . Staff C's personnel file contained no documentation of receiving 2 hours of ECC in-service training. On at 10: 11 a.m., Staff A said she had worked there over a year and had not received ECC training. On at 10:40 a.m., the Business Office Manager said they had not been doing ECC training since she had been there and that corporate said they did not have to do it because they have no ECC residents. On at 11:35 a.m., the ED said he would speak with corporate regarding the 2 hour ECC in-service training for direct care staff within 6 months of hire. Class III
