0000 - Initial Comments An unannounced relicensure survey was conducted on at Harbor Inn South, an assisted living Facility, (license number #9691), in Venice, Florida. The following is description of the deficiency. 0152 - Physical Plant - Safe Living Environ/Other - 58A-5.023(3) FAC Based on observation and interviews, the facility was not free of a potential hazard for 1 (Resident #2) of 5 residents. The findings included: On at 1:15 p.m., Resident #2's bed was observed to have a siderail that was unattached to the frame of the bed creating a potential hazard. The base of the siderail was observed to slide between the mattress and the box spring and was movable. On at 1:17 p.m., caregiver Staff C said the resident's family had brought the rail in after he was first admitted. She said the resident did not really use it. On at 1:20 p.m., discussed with the facility's owner the unattached side rail was a potential hazard for the resident. She confirmed the siderail was not attached to the frame of the bed and said she would have it removed. Class III
