0000 - Initial Comments A re-licensure survey with limited mental health (LMH) services was conducted on . Living Southern Style of Brevard LLC, License#12363, had deficiencies at the time of the visit. 0167 - Resident Contracts - 58A-5.025 FAC Based on record review and interview, the facility failed to ensure resident contracts had all the required information for 1 of 2 sampled resident record reviewed (#1). Findings: Record review for resident 1 revealed a contract dated . The contract did not contain a provision that residents must be assessed upon admission pursuant to subsection 58A-5.0181(2), Florida Administrative Code, and every 3 years thereafter, or after a significant change, pursuant to subsection (4) of that rule. On . at 5:30 PM, the administrator confirmed resident #1 did not have the required information in his/her contract. Class 1243 - LMH - Training - 429.075(1) FS; 58A-5.0191(8) FAC Based on personnel record review and interview, the facility failed to ensure staff received Limited Mental Health (LMH) training within 6 months of employment for 2 of 3 sampled staff (A & C). Findings: A review of the facility's license revealed the facility was licensed to provide LMH Services. Staff A's and Staff C's personnel records did not have documentation of the required 6 hours of LMH training within 6 months of employment. Staff A was hired on . and Staff C was hired . Further review of Staff C's record revealed no documentation for a minimum of 3 hours of LMH updated training that was required biennially thereafter. On . at 5:30 PM, the administrator confirmed that both staff did not have the required 6-hour LMH training. Staff C also did not have the required LMH updated training. Class III
