0000 - Initial Comments

A review of Unsatisfactory "State of Florida Department of Health County Health Department Group Care Inspection Reports" was conducted on . Stillwater Alf Corp had a deficiency.

D152 - Physical Plant - Safe Living Environ/Other - 58A-5.023(3) FAC

Based on review of Unsatisfactory "Department of Health (DOH) County Health Department Inspection Reports" and interview, the facility did not maintain a safe living environment free of hazards.

Findings:

The "Department of Health (DOH) County Health Department Inspection Reports" reflected the following.

1. The inspection was unsatisfactory with the following violations:

Violation #3 Bacteriological/Chemical - "The facility is past due for their quarterly sampling. This needs to be completed ASAP (as soon as possible)."

Violation #7 Maintenance - There was a build up of dust on the vent and wall in the the tv . This needs to be cleaned."

Violation #21 Lighting/Ft. Candles - "There were some missing and out lights at the time of the inspection. Ensure all lights are in good working condition."

"Violation #3 needs to be completed by ."

2. The inspection was unsatisfactory with the following violations:

Violation #3 Bacteriological/Chemical - "The facility is past due for their quarterly sampling. This needs to be completed ASAP."

Violation #17 Maintenance - "There was a build up of dust on the vent and wall in the the tv . This needs to be cleaned."

Violation #21 Lighting/Ft. Candles - "There were some missing and out lights at the time of the inspection. Ensure all lights are good working condition."
