SUMMARY STATEMENT OF DEFICIENCIES
(FINDINGS PRECEDED BY TAGS AND REGULATORY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION)

0000 - Initial Comments

An unannounced complaint survey for CCR#2017001309 was conducted at Inspired Living at Sarasota, an assisted living facility (license #12463) in Sarasota, Florida.

The complaint contained 1 allegation, which was substantiated with deficiency.

The following is description of the deficiency.

0056 - Medication - Labeling and Orders - 58A-5.0185(7) FAC

Based on record review and interview, the facility failed to ensure timely reordering of residents medication for 3(Resident #1, #2, and #3) of 4 resident reviewed. This has the potential for resident to suffer negative consequences from missed dosages of medications.

The findings included:

1. The Medication Observation Record (MOR) for Resident #1 documented that on and the resident missed his dosage of Hippurate. The missed dosage for those days was documented as medication was "not available - waiting on pharmacy."
2. The MOR for Resident #2 documented that on and the resident missed a dosage of The documentation for missed dosages said "waiting on pharmacy delivery."
3. The MOR for Resident #3 documented that the resident missed the evening dosage for on The MOR also documented the resident did not receive the dosage scheduled for the morning, midday, and bedtime on The documentation for missed dosages gives the reason as "waiting on pharmacy delivery."
4. On at 11:50 a.m., the Health and Wellness Director said she could not say why the residents' medications were not re-ordered to be available for administration. She indicated that the facility does have a new nurse that might not understand the process.
