Deficient practice was identified at the time of the survey. 0026 - Resident Care - Social & Leisure Activities - 58A-5.0182(2) FAC Based on observation and interview, the facility failed to provide an ongoing activities program for each resident's needs, abilities and interest for 6 of 6 sampled residents. (Residents #1, #2, #3, #4, #5, & #6) Findings include: On an observation was conducted for daily scheduled activities of bingo at 2:00pm and word puzzles at 2:35pm posted on the activity board. The scheduled activities did not occur as posted on the activity board. She stated that they needed resident council meetings so she could voice her opinions about activities. On an interview with resident #4 revealed that he would like to have more games to play. On approximately 1:58pm an interview with the Administrator was conducted pertaining to the scheduled activities that were posted. The Administrator stated she claimed resident activity hours from their day treatment hours.
