0000 - Initial Comments

Assisted Living Facility

A revisit to complaint surveys, (CCR# 2017000971 and CCR# 2017003232), was conducted at Jennifer Gardens, Assisted Living Facility, on with an uncorrected deficiency identified at the time of the visit.

0081 - Training - Staff In-Service - 58A-5.0191(2) FAC

Based on record review and interview the facility failed to ensure that all staff receive the required facility in-service trainings within 30-days of employment for four employees (A, B, C, and D) of four sampled employees.

Findings included:

An employee record review conducted on for Staff A, revealed documentation for a 2-hour ADL & Behavioral Needs Training versus a 3-hour training requirement. Staff A's employee record did not contain documentation for the following trainings: Control, Recognizing & Reporting, Nutrition & Safe Food Handling, and Resident Rights within 30-days of hire date.

An employee record review conducted on for Staff B, revealed no documentation for Resident Rights training. Staff B's employee record did not contain documentation for the following trainings: Control and Recognizing & Reporting within 30-days of hire date.

An employee record review conducted on for Staff C, employee revealed documentation for a 2-hour ADL & Behavioral Needs Training versus a 3-hour training requirement and no documentation for Resident Rights Training. Staff C's employee record did not contain documentation for the following trainings: Control, Recognizing & Reporting, Nutrition & Safe Food Handling, Elopement, Emergency Preparedness, Incident Reporting within 30-days of hire date.

A focused employee record review conducted on for Staff D, revealed documentation for a

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2-hour ADL & Behavioral Needs Training versus a 3-hour training requirement and no documentation for Resident Rights Training. An interview conducted on [redacted] at 02:50pm the Administrator confirmed and acknowledged each employee was missing in-service trainings and that some in-service trainings are greater than 30-days from date of hire. The Administrator stated that we have a high turnover lately, it is hard to keep up with all the trainings, and I will get those done. Class III
