SUMMARY STATEMENT OF DEFICIENCIES (FINDINGS PRECEDED BY TAGS AND REGULATORY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION)		
0000 - Initial Comments An unannounced complaint survey for allegations contained within CCR#2017007157 was conducted in conjunction with an abbreviated biennial survey on through at Emerald Gardens Assisted Living Facility, license #11667. Deficient practice was identified at the time of the survey. 0053 - Medication - Administration - 58A-5.0185(4) FAC Based on observation, interview, and record review, the facility failed to ensure unlicensed staff did not administer medications to 1 of 1 residents sampled (#13) who required medication administration. Findings include: A medication observation was conducted on at 09:33 AM. Staff B, an unlicensed medication technician (med tech) was observed to obtain the medications for resident #13. Med tech B was observed to put 4 pills in a pill cup and hand them to the resident who then swallowed them. In addition, the med tech was observed to put eye drops into the left eye of the resident. Resident #13's 1823 was reviewed. On, the resident was assessed by her physician. Section 2, subsection B of the form indicated the type of assistance required for medications. The resident was coded as "needs medication administration." An interview was conducted with the Administrator on at 2:28 PM. She stated that only med techs pass medications in the building. When asked what part of the 1823 indicates med techs can pass medications, she stated they can only give medications for residents marked for self-administration. She then reviewed resident #13's 1823 and agreed it stated the resident required medication administration and that only a nurse could give resident #13 her medications. She stated she would contact the resident's physician. Class III
