On , an unannounced complaint survey for allegations contained within CCR# 2017007878 was conducted at Provision Living at Panama City, license #10754. Deficient practice was identified at the time of the survey.

Based on record review and staff interview the facility failed to ensure staff employee files contained a signed and dated Affidavit of Compliance with Background Screening Requirements (AHCA form 3100-0008) or a similar document attesting under penalty of perjury that they are in compliance with Chapter 435, F.S. for 1 of 6 sampled current employees. (employee F)

The findings include:

Review of employee F's (resident aide) record revealed a hire date of . The record contained a blank Affidavit of Compliance with Background Screening Requirements. An interview was conducted with the facility Administrator on at approximately 1:05 PM. The Administrator confirmed the document was not signed by the employee and stated the Business Office Manager was responsible for ensuring the document was signed.
