SUMMARY STATEMENT OF DEFICIENCIES

0000 - Initial Comments

An unannounced complaint survey (CCR#2017012556) was conducted on at The Pavilion at Bayview Assisted Living Facility (License # 9470). Pavillion at Bayview had deficiencies identified at the time of the survey.

0183 - Emergency Mgmt - Facility Evacuation - 58A-5.026(4) FAC

Based on record review and interview, the facility failed to evacuate its residents during a mandatory evacuation order given during Hurricane Irma on the dates through with the potential to affect all 31 residents who remained at the facility during the evacuation order.

The findings include:

During a telephone interview with a representative from the Division of Emergency Management (DEM) on at 8:40 AM, the following information was given: A mandatory evacuation order was given by the Division of Emergency Management on Saturday at 6:00 AM, due to the facility's location in flood Zone B during Hurricane Irma. He stated the DEM was in contact with the facility's administration to assist in the evacuation efforts. The evacuation order was lifted on at 12:00 PM.

A record review of the facility approved Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) showed an approval date of . The CEMP listed 6 facilities that would receive residents in the event of an emergency evacuation. (photographic evidence obtained)

A follow up interview was conducted with a representative of the facility's administration on at 9:48 AM. He confirmed he was in contact with the DEM during the Hurricane and was aware of the evacuation order. He confirmed the facility did not evacuate any of its residents following the order given on , and they stayed in the facility for the duration of the storm.
