Resident #1's facility notes on _____ stated, "resident was found with a steak knife in his hands, Resident was threatening to cut aide, resident states that he was protecting himself from a man. Knife was taken from him." On _____ Resident #1 was transferred to the hospital. Resident #1's facility notes on _____ revealed the facility documented that the resident was inappropriate for ALF. The facility failed to provide documentation that Resident #1 was certified by a physician to require an emergency relocation to a facility providing a more skilled level of care or that the resident engaged in a pattern of conduct that is harmful or offensive to other residents .
