0000 - Initial Comments

On an unannounced complaint survey (CCR2017006814, license #25) was conducted at Good Samaritan Retirement Home in Williston. Deficient practice was identified as a result of the survey.

0093 - Food Service - Dietary Standards - 58A-5.020(2) FAC

Based on observation and interview the facility failed to maintain a 3-day supply of nonperishable food and water supply for 32 of 32 resident of the facility.

Findings:

On at 11:30 AM, the three day nonperishable emergency food supply was observed to lack adequate food for the number of resident in the facility, food available in storage included four 6 lbs corned beef hash cans, two 6 lbs collard greens cans, two 7 lb vanilla pudding cans, five 7 lb baked beans cans, two 6 lbs spaghetti Sause cans, two 6 lbs cans, two 2 lbs oat cereal boxes, one 2 lb corn flakes box, two 5 lbs peanut butter containers, five 96 Fl. oz apple juices, two 7 lbs pork and beans cans, four 4 lb baked tuna cans, six packs of milk each containing eight 12 Fl. oz. containers, four 6.6 lb whole kernel corn cans, Two packs of spaghetti each containing six 1 lb packages. Observation of the emergency water supply included three packs containing 35 bottles, each with 16.9 Fl. oz., five 1 gallon bottles, one 2.5 gallon water, totaling approximately 21.5 gallons. The facility's census is currently 32 residents at time of survey.

On at 12:48 PM, the facility's Administration confirmed the inadequacy of the 3-day emergency food and water supply stored for the residents of the facility. The Administrator stated that he would notify the facility's owners to restock the nonperishable food and water supply to ensure that the facility is in compliance.
