0000 - Initial Comments An unannounced visit for Complaints # 2017009126 and 2017011739 was conducted on at Riverwood Lodge Assisted Living Facility in Fort White, Florida. Deficiencies were identified. License # 12714. 0152 - Physical Plant - Safe Living Environ/Other - 58A-5.023(3) FAC Based on observation, record review and interview the facility failed to provide or maintain proper lighting in 5 of 14 in use in the facility (# 19, 11, 1, 2, 4), unsecured canister and faulty alert /alarm pendant system. Findings: During an observational tour conducted on beginning at 8:00 AM, with Staff A and B present , the following issues were noted: A full size canister with no stand, unsecured in the open Nurse's station. 5 of 14 ceiling lights with only 1 light bulb, so it was very dim. There was no bedside lamp provided by the facility for the resident. # 19, 11, 1, 2, 4. Residents observed wearing the Life Alert pendants around their necks or hanging near their beds in their . The Monitoring system in the Nurse's station does not always work properly due to a cable. Random interviews conducted with the Residents in 19, 11, 2, 1, and 4 beginning at 8:20 AM on revealed they wanted more light in their . They stated the lighting was too dim for reading. In 4 and 11 the residents were attempting to read books. In the resident stated she did not have enough light when she tried to do other activities in the . Random interviews with Residents beginning at 9:00 AM on wearing the Life Alert pendant stated there have been instances when the system was not working and they had to go to the staff for assistance. During an interview with Staff A she confirmed the Life Alert monitoring modem in the Nurse's station does not work consistently.

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During an interview with the Administrator on at 11:00 AM, she confirmed she was going to remove the Life Alert system since has not been the best form of communication in this facility .
