0000 - Initial Comments An unannounced Complaint survey 2017010178, 2017010857, 2017010919, and 2017011957 was conducted on 13-14, 2018 at Midtown Manor ALF, a 105 bed ALF, License #6508. The facility had deficiencies at the time of the visit. 0032 - Resident Care - Elopement Standards - 58A-5.0182(8) FAC Based on record review and interview, the facility failed to provide proper supervision and preventative measures to ensure that one of five sampled residents (Resident #1) reviewed did not elope from the facility. The findings include: Record review revealed Resident #1 was admitted to the facility on , with diagnoses including and ; and requires assistance with Self-Administration of Medications. During an interview on at 1:45 PM, the Administrator was asked if Resident #1 had ever left the facility without their knowledge. The Administrator reported that on , the resident wandered off and went to a beauty shop and police brought the resident back to the facility . Review of the facility's documentation regarding Resident #1's elopement dated states, "Around PM resident walked out of dining . Staff began to search for resident throughout the building including all , clients , laundry , TV , etc. Outside building, search as well. 911 called & notified of missing resident." Facility received called from "caregiver to resident at home" stating that the residents's family member had Resident #1 and will not provide location until Administrator calls her back. Admin called (individual), address provided and police notified. Resident #1 was picked up by police and brought back to the facility." Class III
