0000 - Initial Comments An unannounced CHOW survey was conducted on at Colonial Assisted Living Facility at Fort Lauderdale, License # 7249. The facility had a deficiency at the time of the visit. 0056 - Medication - Labeling and Orders - 58A-5.0185(7) FAC Based on record review and interview, the facility failed to ensure resident was able to request "as needed" medication for 1 of 2 sampled residents (Resident#3). The Findings Included: Review of Resident #3 file documented an admission date of The Resident's Health Assessment (AHCA form 1823) dated On documented diagnosis as Mild A review of Resident#3's Medication Observation Record (MOR) was completed. Resident#3 was prescribed Lorazepam 0.5mg. Tablet - 0.5mg. ; take 1 tablet by mouth every 4 hours "as needed" for agitation, NMT (Not More Than) 4 in 24Hours. Review of the Medication Observation Record for 2018 revealed the Medication Techs assist with self administration of the Lorazepam. During an interview with Staff A, it was revealed that when the resident appears agitated (i.e. yelling, , combative) she is given the Lorazepam for agitation by the med tech. Further review of the MOR revealed the medication is always given by the med techs (..... to current date), and the reason given/documented as C/O of agitation. On at approximately 12:00PM until 12:55PM, observation and attempted interview with Resident#3 revealed she is not cognizant of when the medication is needed and the purpose for taking the medication. Due to the residents inability to request the "as needed" medication, a licensed professional is required to make the determination of the need for the medication to be given and document it's effectiveness. Furthermore, the facility had not contacted the primary care physician to discuss the resident increased need of the medication related to behavior (agitation).
