SUMMARY STATEMENT OF DEFICIENCIES
(FINDINGS PRECEDED BY TAGS AND REGULATORY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION)

0000 - Initial Comments

An unannounced Complaint Survey, CCR #2018003154, was conducted on , 2018 at Safe Harbor Assisted Living Resort, (License #9568). The facility had a deficiency identified at the time of the visit.

0030 - Resident Care - Rights & Facility Procedures - 58A-5.0182(6) FAC; 429.28(1-2) FS

Based on observation, resident interview and staff interview, the facility failed to provide a safe living environment free of bedbugs, insects or rodents for five of eight sampled residents (resident #2, #3, #4, #8 and #9). The facility also failed to address the residents concerns regarding the presence of bedbugs and other pests in the facility.

Findings Include:

During the investigation, four of eight residents interviewed (#2, #3, #4 and #8) stated that they had seen bedbugs. During confidential interviews on between the hours of 10 AM and 3 PM, the following was revealed.

Resident #2 stated "The place is inundated with bedbugs. I kill them myself." While speaking, the resident pointed to a bug on the blanket that had been killed. Surveyor observed the presence of bedbugs.

Resident #3 stated that he/she has seen bedbugs and have been bitten by them (pointing to arms). "I been buying things for and stuff." Resident #3 also stated that there are "rats running, around and iguana lizards."

Resident #4 stated that "they try to clean the bugs. I see them and I kill them. Every two weeks they clean, they spray." The bugs are still present.

Resident #8 stated "yeah, I seen bedbugs. "Haven't been bit lately." Resident said that "they spray once a month."

Resident #9 stated "they have had rats and roaches (in the)." This surveyor observed that the entry door to the resident's apartment has two large size holes at the bottom that are large enough for rats and other rodents to come through.

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During the exit interview between 2:40 PM and 2:57 PM, employee A acknowledged the existence of bedbugs in the facility. This surveyor asked employee A what was being done to remedy the bedbug situation. Employee A stated "yes, we spray once a month and in the middle of the month. They was just here on Thursday to treat for bed bugs." Employee A provider this surveyor a copy of the recent treatment by the pest control provider. Class III
