0000 - Initial Comments A Change of Ownership (CHOW) second revisit survey was conducted by desk review on for Argo Senior Living at Haverhill, License #8091. The facility has one uncorrected deficiency identified at the time of the desk review. 0181 - Emergency Plan Approval - 58A-5.026(2) FAC Based on record review and an interview, the facility failed to submit their Comprehensive Emergency Management Plan (CEMP) to the county for review and approval, as required . The findings included: During interview with the facility's Administrator on at 10:00 AM, she stated that she did not know if the CEMP had been submitted, or if there was an approved plan with the county. She was unable to locate any documentation showing approval of the CEMP by the county at this time. On at 10:38 AM, a county representative with the Division of Emergency Management stated that the facility's CEMP had not yet been submitted for a "Second Revision Review" as of this date for their annual approval by the county. The facility's plan had been submitted twice since the initial deadline for annual review on or before The county has mailed letters dated and to notify the facility of the need for revisions. The facility had until to submit their last revised plan for a "Second Revision Review", but has not. During a interview with the Administrator on at 12:30 PM by phone, it was revealed the facility still does not have a current approved CEMP by the local Emergency Management Agency . According to the Administrator, the facility has had multiple changes with respect to the Administrator over the last few months and that none had followed up on the status. The Administrator , stated that he is working diligently to expedite the CEMP corrections and resubmit to the Emergency Management Division for review and approval. The Administrator was also unable to demonstrate that the facility had complied with the "second revision Review " request deadline of by the Emergency Management Division. Class III Uncorrected
