0000 - Initial Comments A Standard Biennial Survey was conducted on August 6, 2018. Marcia Adult Care # 1, Inc. (license #10575) had the following deficiency found at time of survey: D162 - Records - Resident - 58A-5.024(3) FAC Based on observation, record review, and interview facility failed to have an accurate health assessment completed for two out of four sampled residents (#2 and #4). Findings included: Review of Resident #2's record revealed health assessment completed on 8/6/2018. The resident stated that the resident requires medication administration (pages 2, 3 and 4 did not have the resident's name and date of birth). On 8/6/2018 at 2:20 PM the Administrator stated, "she does not need medication administration." At 2:25 PM the Administrator stated, "she is going to the doctor tomorrow. I will tell her niece to get a new health assessment." Review of Resident #4's record revealed he is receiving hospice services since 8/6/2018. The last last health assessment was completed on 8/6/2018 and stated that the resident required total assistance with activities of daily living and medication administration. Page #1 was missing the height and weight, the nursing/treatment/therapy service requirements was left blank and special precautions and elopement risk was also left blank and page #3 was left blank and had no name. On 8/6/2018 at 1:30 PM the Administrator stated Resident #4's wife brought the health assessment and that she will tell the hospice doctor to complete a new one. On 8/6/2018 at 1:47 PM Resident # 4 was observed being transferred from the recliner to the wheelchair with the assistance of the two caregivers and he was able to stand up and assist with transfer. On 8/6/2018 at 1:48 PM the Administrator stated at 1:48 PM, "Resident # 4 is able to stand up." Class III
