0000 - Initial Comments An unannounced revisit survey was conducted on _____ at La Colonia II ALF Inc, an assisted living facility (license #12331) in Cape Coral, Florida. This was a third follow-up to the relicensure survey completed on _____. The following is a description of the deficiency found uncorrected at the time of the visit. 0030 - Resident Care - Rights & Facility Procedures - 58A-5.0182(6) FAC; 429.28(1-2) FS Based on observation, record review and staff interview, the facility failed to honor resident's right by not properly utilizing half rails for one (Resident #6) of two residents with bed rails in the facility. According to the Florida Statutes 429.41 3. (k), The use of physical _____ is limited to half-bed rails as prescribed and documented by the resident's physician with the consent of the resident or, the resident's representative or designee or the resident's surrogate, guardian, or attorney in fact. The findings included: On _____ at 7:31 a.m., Resident #6's bed was found to be placed up against the wall. On the opposite side off the bed two half rails were observed attached to the bed, covering the whole length of the bed. Both rails were in the lowered position. During the course of the observation Caregiver Staff A was present and on _____ at 7:34 a.m., said that she worked in the facility during the night. She said both rails were up during the night. She said Resident #6 had a tendency to get up and wander during the night and he also had a tendency to _____. She said the bed rails prevented him from falling or wandering. She said they used them every night and put them up when Resident #6 is in bed. Observation by surveyor on previous survey visit (_____) revealed that Resident #6 was not able to lower the bed rails and he is dependent on staff for all Activities of Daily Living. On _____ at 11:00 a.m., the owner said he did not realize that bed rails that that cover the entire length of the bed cannot be used. He said no one ever told him that. Class III
