SUMMARY STATEMENT OF DEFICIENCIES

0000 - Initial Comments

An unannounced complaint survey for CCR#2018010410 was conducted at Discovery Village at the Forum LLC, an assisted living facility (license #12420) in Fort Myers, Florida.

The complaint contained two allegations of which one was substantiated with a deficiency.

The following is description of the deficiency.

D152 - Physical Plant - Safe Living Environ/Other - 58A-5.023(3) FAC

Based on observation and staff interview, the facility failed to ensure the kitchen was clean and sanitary.

The findings included:

On at 10:30 p.m., the following observations occurred in the facility's kitchen:

- The large refrigerator had trays of food (fruit cups, cottage cheese, desserts and large containers of soup) that were uncovered and not dated.
- The large refrigerator had several areas where food was spilled on the floor.
- The grill, stove and oven had caked on food, grease, food particles and dirt on them.
- The prep-sandwich station had food particles, toothpick, crumbs and spilt food throughout the station.
- Food splattered on the wall next to the large mixer.
- The large mixer had food particles and splattered substance throughout.
- Wet nesting with several platters, pots and pans.
- The small mixer had caked-on food where the mixing utensil is placed.
- The bottom shelves at the tray line area where the cooks prepare the resident meals had food particles, splattered substance and dirt.

On at 11:00 p.m., the administrator confirmed these observations.
