0000 - Initial Comments On _____, 2018, an unannounced complaint investigation (CCR #2018016073) survey was conducted at Tangerine Cove of Brooksville Assisted Living Facility (License #7622), Brooksville, FL. Deficient practice was identified at the time of the survey. 0152 - Physical Plant - Safe Living Environ/Other - 58A-5.023(3) FAC Based on observation and interview, the facility failed to provide a safe living environment free from hazards for 1 (Resident #1) of 99 residents observed. Findings: On _____ at 10:35 AM, Resident #1 was observed lying in bed on her back with her right hand pulling at the blinds on the window to her right. The blinds were tattered with slats missing. The bed was against the wall under the window. An interview was conducted with the Wellness Director on _____ at 10:35 AM. She stated Resident #1 always pulled at her blinds. On _____ at 3:30 PM, Resident #1 was again observed pulling and kicking at the broken blinds hanging on the window next to the bed. The resident's bed was up against the wall, under the window, which allowed her access to the blinds (Photographic evidence obtained). An interview was conducted with the Administrator on _____ at 4:15 PM. When asked about the condition of the blinds in Resident #1's _____, the Administrator confirmed that they were being pulled and broken by the resident. She confirmed the blinds could be a safety hazard for the resident if she pulled them completely off the window or cut/scratched herself by the individual slats. She stated she would talk to her Psych Physician about the blinds. She also stated she would request that maintenance take the blinds down tomorrow. Class III		

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
