0000 - Initial Comments An unannounced complaint survey for CCR#2018015911 was conducted on _____ at Sunset Lake Village, an assisted living facility (license #11964825) located in Venice, Florida. The complaint contained 2 allegations, of which 1 was substantiated with deficiency. The following is description of the deficiency. 0030 - Resident Care - Rights & Facility Procedures - 58A-5.0182(6) FAC; 429.28() FS 429.27 Based on a observation, record review, and interview, the facility failed to ensure the resident's personal belongings were kept safe for 3 (Residents #4, #5, and #6) of 6 residents reviewed, resulting in the loss of the resident's belongings. The findings included: A review of the grievance log revealed on _____ Resident #4 reported missing laundry, Resident #6 reported money missing that went through laundry, and Resident #5 reported on _____ that he was missing laundry. A review of the resident council meeting minutes revealed on _____, a resident said the laundry personnel should keep things separated while folding so no one got someone else's laundry. On _____, one of the residents would like her personal laundry hangers returned. On _____, 2 residents reported a lot of the residents clothing has been disappearing into the laundry and not coming _____. On _____ at 1:45 p.m., the Memory Care Resident Care Coordinator said the staff does laundry around the clock when it is necessary. Most of the residents in the memory care unit are _____ so they do a lot of laundry. Staff would not throw away any laundry unless the laundry was too badly soiled to get clean. They would confirm with the family if they were going to destroy the clothing or linens. On _____ at 3:10 p.m., Resident #5 said he is still having trouble getting his laundry _____. On _____ the Executive Director, the Memory Care Program Manager, the Interim Executive Director, and the Wellness Director agreed they have been returning laundry but have not evaluated their system for laundry to ensure the resident's belongings were returned to them. They confirmed they thought the laundry system was working.		

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On . at 1:30 p.m., Staff A said the residents each have a basket where the dirty laundry is placed. Once the basket is full, one of the staff is supposed to wash it. This is normally done on shower day, but if the resident's basket is full prior to shower day one staff is still supposed to wash it. He said the clothing is supposed to be marked with the resident's name. He said all residents in the memory care unit are missing laundry at times. He said he doesn't think their system works very well. Class III
