0000 - Initial Comments On , an unannounced Extended Congregate Care and Limited Nursing Services monitoring survey was conducted at Cranes View Lodge, license #12546. The facility was not in compliance at the time of the survey. 0052 - Medication - Assistance with Self-Admin - 58A-5.0185 (3) Base on observations and interviews the facility failed to provide assistance with self administration of medication as required for 1 of 2 residents, for resident #1. On at 10:01 AM, an observation was made of Staff A, a Medication Technician (MT) assisting a resident #1 with assistance of self-administration of medication. The MT was observed removing the residents medication from the medication cart and push each medication (5 in total) through the packaging into a medication cup. The MT handed the medication cup to the resident and stated, "Here are your morning pills, including your , ." The MT then assisted the resident with their medication. The MT did not bring the medication in its original packaging to the resident, and did not read the medication label aloud to the resident. On /017 at 10:09 AM, an interview was conducted with Staff A. Staff A acknowledged that she did not read the label medication to the resident in its original packaging, and did not read the medication label aloud to the resident. A review was conducted of the facility Policy and Procedure Manual which contained a policy titled, "Medication Management: Assistance with Self-Administration or Supervision of Medication by Unlicensed Personnel," effective date . The policy states, "Unlicensed assistance with self-administration includes the following tasks: Taking the medication (in its previously dispensed, properly labeled container) from where it is stored in preparation to assist with self-administration; In the presence of the resident, reading the label, telling the resident why the medication is prescribed (i.e. pill, , pill, etc.), opening the container, removing the prescribed amount (without touching the medication) and closing the container."
