0000 - Initial Comments Assisted Living Facility A revisit to a Complaint (CCR#20180156170 in conjunction with a complaint investigation (CCR# 2018018414) was conducted on at Loving Care of St. Petersburg (License # 11357) an Assisted Living Facility in St. Petersburg, FL. There were deficiencies identified at the time of survey. 0152 - Physical Plant - Safe Living Environ/Other - 58A-5.023(3) FAC Based on observation and interview, the facility failed to provide a safe living environment for all residents (63), free of hazards. Findings Include: During a tour of the facility on beginning at 9:27am, the following was observed: a drawer with rodent feces in it on the second floor in a desk, a dirty shower with broken floor tiles in a second floor bathroom, a dirty bathroom sink and broken toilet in On the first floor in the residents' bathroom there were what appeared to be feces in the toilet, on the toilet and on the floor. Further observation during the tour revealed the shower in this bathroom had a medication cup which covered the drain and was full of a yellow-colored fluid and a towel in the shower covered in a dark brown substance. Lastly, the water cooler on the first floor was dirty, the floor under it had water on it and the floor tiles were chipped and broken. During a walkthrough of the facility with the Facility Director and Administrator conducted on at 12:05pm, both staff observed the physical plant concerns and confirmed the facility is need of repairs .
