0000 - Initial Comments A complaint investigation (complaint numbers 2019008206 and 2019007762) was conducted at Sunny Hills of Sebring (Assisted Living Facility) on Deficiencies were identified at the time of the survey. 0025 - Resident Care - Supervision - 429.26(7) FS; 58A-5.0182(1) FAC Based on record review and interview the facility failed to maintain a general awareness of the residents whereabouts for 3 (Residents #1, #3 and #4) of 3 residents sampled. Findings Included: A record review of adverse incident reports conducted on revealed that the facility had 3 elopements: resident #1 on (Last seen at 6pm) resulting in law enforcement contacting the facility, resident #3 on (Last seen at 7pm) resulting in law enforcement returning the resident to the facility and resident #4 on (Last seen at 5:10pm) was across the street from the facility. These 3 elopements occurred during the hours of 5pm-7pm. (photographic evidence obtained) Resident interviews conducted on revealed that the front doors are not locked at night or they didn't know if they were locked at night. Staff interviews conducted on revealed that the front doors are locked at night by the night shift or the staff didn't know if they were locked at night. During an interview conducted on at 3:13pm, the Administrator confirmed that front doors are locked at night. The Administrator stated "It does 11pm when 11pm-7am comes in MT will lock it." During an interview conducted on at 4:06pm, the Administrator confirmed that the elopements had happened during the time period of 5:00pm-7:00pm. The Administrator stated "Yes we need to look at what we can do to decrease the elopements." Class III
