0000 - Initial Comments A biennial relicensure with extended congregate care was conducted at The Preserve at Clearwater on to Deficiencies were identified at the time of survey. 0052 - Medication - Assistance with Self-Admin - 429.256() ; 58A-5.0185 (3) Based on observation, interview and record review the facility failed to assist with self-administration of medications appropriately for two residents (# 14 and #15) of three sampled residents. Findings included: During a medication pass observation conducted on, Staff D, an unlicensed staff, was observed not reading the label in the presence of the resident and not comparing the medication label to the medication observation record (MOR) of Resident's # 14 and #15. In an interview with Staff D conducted on at 12:08 PM Staff D confirmed that the label was not read to Resident #14 and that the medication label was not compared to the MOR for Resident #15. In an interview with the Community Wellness Director (CWD) conducted on at 12:30 PM confirmed that the expectation of a med tech during a med pass would be to compare the medication label to the MOR and read the label in the presence of the resident. A record review conducted on of the facility's Policy and Procedure for Medication Administration with an effective date of, section 8. Assistance with self-administration: This includes: " Reading the label to the resident, opening the container, removing the prescribed amount of medication and closing the container. The facility's policy and procedure was not followed during the medication pass by Staff D. Class III 0053 - Medication - Administration - 58A-5.0185(4) FAC Based on observation, interview and record review the facility failed to provide licensed staff to assist with medication administration for Resident # 14 of three sampled residents.

Findings included: On , Staff D, an unlicensed staff, was observed during a medication pass observation at 12:07 PM providing medication administration to Resident #14. An employee record review for Staff D, conducted on , revealed Staff D, with a date of hire of , had a six hour med tech training taken on . Staff D is not a licensed profession qualified to administer medication. In an interview with Staff D, conducted on at 12:23 PM, Staff D confirmed that as a med tech they are not allowed to administer medication to a resident. During an interview with the Community Wellness Director (CWD) conducted on at 12:30 PM it was confirmed by the CWD that a med tech is not allowed to administer medication to a resident. A record review of Resident # 14 conducted on revealed that the resident did not require medication administration and was capable of assistance with self- administration of medications. A record review conducted on of the facility's Policy and Procedure for Medication Administration with an effective date of , section 9. Medication administration: Only a licensed nurse will administer medication to residents who are physically or mentally unable to take their own medications in accordance with their health care provider's directions. The facility's policy and procedure was not followed during the medication pass by Staff D. Class III
