The department and agency reserve the right to attend and monitor all facility in-service training, which is intended to meet regulatory requirements. (r) Additional resident records requirements for facilities holding a limited mental health, extended congregate care, or limited nursing services license are provided in Rules 58A-5.029, 58A-5.030 and 58A-5.031, F.A.C., respectively.
