(6) Any resident accepted in a facility and placed by the department or the Department of Children and Families shall have been examined by medical personnel within 30 days before placement in the facility. The examination shall include an assessment of the appropriateness of placement in a facility. The findings of this examination shall be recorded on the examination form provided by the agency. The completed form shall accompany the resident and shall be submitted to the facility owner or administrator. Additionally, in the case of a mental health resident, the Department of Children and Families must provide documentation that the individual has been assessed by a psychiatrist, clinical psychologist, clinical social worker, or nurse, or an individual who is supervised by one of these professionals, and determined to be appropriate to reside in an assisted living facility. The documentation must be in the facility within 30 days after the mental health resident has been admitted to the facility. Faxed or electronic copies of the completed form are acceptable. The form must be completed as instructed. 1. Information received orally must include the name of the health care provider, the name of the facility staff recording the information, and the date the information was provided. 3. Building #1 is the assisted living facility located across the street from the memory care facility. The distance from the memory care unit to the assisted living facility is approximately 800 Staff at the assisted living facility notified the staff at the Memory care unit and the resident was brought to the Memory care unit via wheelchair. The resident stated he was trying to go to a funeral home. The resident was assessed by the nurse at the time with no injuries. The facility notified the family and health care provider. Local law enforcement was not called. Review of the facility's elopement policy revealed the staff is to monitor all exit doors when an alarm occurs. All residents are to be accounted for and the local police is to be called if resident is not located. Review of the personnel records for Staff D and Staff E revealed the staff had completed the facility's elopement training at their time of hire and completed elopement drills throughout the year. The resident then walked outside, not being noticed by staff, and walked across the street to the assisted living building, approximately 800 . . . from the memory care building, having to cross a busy street in the early morning hours of 5:30 am. An individual with a positive test must submit a health care provider's statement that the individual does not constitute a risk of 2. (2) Every facility licensed under this part is required to maintain adverse incident reports. For purposes of this section, the term, "adverse incident" means: (a) An event over which facility personnel could exercise control rather than as a result of the resident's condition and results in: 1. _____; 2. _____ or _____ damage; 3. (3) Licensed facilities shall provide within 1 business day after the occurrence of an adverse incident, by electronic mail, facsimile, or United States mail, a preliminary report to the agency on all adverse incidents specified under this section. The report must include information regarding the identity of the affected resident, the type of adverse incident, and the status of the facility's investigation of the incident. (4) Licensed facilities shall provide within 15 days, by electronic mail, facsimile, or United States mail, a full report to the agency on all adverse incidents specified in this section. The report must include the results of the facility's investigation into the adverse incident.
