On behalf of the Calvin Community Assisted Living in Des Moines, I respectfully submit our Plan of Correction for your approval. Our response is specific the compliance visit on October 21 and 22, 2019. Preparation and/or execution of this plan of correction does not constitute admission or agreement by the provider of the truth of the facts alleged or conclusions set forth in the statement of deficiencies. The plan of correction is prepared and/or executed solely because it is required by the provision of state law.

Record Checks

Elements detailing how the Program will correct each regulatory insufficiency.

- Staff A will have background checks completed as required by regulation.
- Background checks will be completed prior to employment as required by regulation.

What measures will be taken to ensure the program does not recur.

- A new hire checklist has been developed to ensure processes are being completed as required for new hires.
- Staff responsible for employment will be retrained on requirements including completing background checks as required by regulation.

How the Program plans to monitor performance to ensure compliance.

The Assistant Director of Nursing or designee will audit staff files at least annually to confirm compliance.

Occupancy Agreement

Elements detailing how the Program will correct each regulatory insufficiency.

- The tenant occupancy agreement has been amended and does include language as required by regulation.
- All tenants will be given a 30 day notice of the new occupancy agreement. This occupancy agreement will be signed and dated by the tenant and/or legal representative and the program.
- The new occupancy agreement will be utilized with future move ins.

What measures will be taken to ensure the program does not recur.

- Staff responsible for initiating occupancy agreement with move ins will be educated on the updated occupancy agreement.

How the Program plans to monitor performance to ensure compliance.

- The occupancy agreement will be updated with any regulatory changes.
- The Assistant Director of Nursing or designee will review occupancy agreement template annually to ensure it meets current regulatory requirements.

The date by which the regulatory insufficiency will be corrected.

The plan of correction will be completed on or before January 2, 2020.
