Maintenance and testing of the generator and transfer switches are performed in accordance with NFPA 110. Generator sets are inspected weekly, exercised under load 30 minutes 12 times a year in 20-40 day intervals, and exercised once every 36 months for 4 continuous hours. Maintenance and testing of stored energy power sources (Type 3 EES) are in accordance with NFPA 111. Main and feeder circuit breakers are inspected annually, and a program for periodically exercising the components is established according to manufacturer requirements. Written records of maintenance and testing are maintained and readily available. EES electrical panels and circuits are marked, readily identifiable, and separate from normal power circuits. Minimizing the possibility of damage of the emergency power source is a design consideration for new installations. 6.4.4, 6.5.4, 6.6.4 (NFPA 99), NFPA 110, NFPA 111, 700.10 (NFPA 70) This REQUIREMENT is not met as evidenced by: Based on observation and interview, the facility failed to provide a remote manual stop station for generator in accordance with NFPA 110 section 5.6.5.6. This deficiency affected all residents in the facility on the day of the survey. Findings Include: On 10/22/23 at 10:40 AM, observation revealed the facility did not have a remote manual stop for the generator. NFPA 110 5.6.5.6: All installations shall have a remote manual stop station of a type to prevent inadvertent or unintentional operation located outside the room housing the prime mover, where so installed, or elsewhere on the premises where the prime mover is located outside the building.	K 918	On 11/12/24 Regional Maintenance Director notified Taylor Sudden Service to install emergency stop switch on the generator. Emergency switch will be installed by 12/5/2024. All residents have the potential to be affected. On 11/15/2024 Maintenance Director conducted a generator check to ensure proper functioning. Beginning the week of 11/18/2024 the Maintenance Director will conduct generator checks to ensure generator is running properly three (3) times a week for four (4) weeks then monthly for three (3) months. The administrator will report to the Quality Assurance Performance
