During the survey, the SA determined that the facility was in compliance with the requirements of participation in Medicare and Medicaid. The SA did not substantiate the complaint for Resident/Patient/Client Neglect, during an incident in which a resident spilled coffee on herself causing a second degree burn to her right leg.
