(a) An offer of employment by an adult care home licensed under this Article to an applicant is conditioned on the applicant's consent to an examination and screening for controlled substances. The examination and screening shall be conducted in accordance with Article 20 of Chapter 95 of the General Statutes. A screening procedure that utilizes a single-use test device may be used for the examination and screening of applicants and may be administered on-site. If the result of an applicant's or employee's examination and screening indicates the presence of a controlled substance, the adult care home may require a second examination and screening to verify the results of the prior examination and screening. This Rule is not met as evidenced by: Based on interview and record review, the facility failed to assure an examination and screening for the presence of controlled substances was performed for 3 of 4 sampled staff (Staff B, C, D) hired after 10/1/13 before the employee began working at the facility.
