C 000	Initial Comments Construction Section Biennial Survey report by Frank Strickland on 07/13/2017: This facility was first licensed as a Home for the Aged serving 59 residents on 08/01/1986. However, a tax document provided by the staff indicates the facility was built and operating in 1965. The facility is currently licensed for 42 Special Care residents. Based on this information, this facility is required to meet the 2005 Rules for the Licensing of Adult Care Homes, and, the 1958 NC State Building Code, Institutional Unrestrained. Deficiencies have been cited and a Plan of Correction is required.	C 000

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C 101	Continued From page 1 This Rule is not met as evidenced by: 1-Based on observations, this facility does not meet the Building Code requirements for Special Locking Arrangements (magnetic locks) in effect at the time of renovation or alteration. Findings on 07/13/2017: a. The required emergency release switch located at each magnetically locked exit door was of the locking type, with keyed switches. The med tech was the only staff member carrying a release switch key and the other staff that were interviewed carried no release switch keys. This is not in conformance with the Code requirement that all staff who are responsible for the evacuation of the occupants must carry an emergency release key at all times when on duty. b. No wiring diagram of the Special Locking System components has been provided mounted adjacent to the fire alarm control panel. c. No on/off centrally controlled emergency release switch was identified at the time of survey.	C 101	A) This issue has been resolved. Findings on 07/13/2017: There are electrical and HVAC piping through the masonry walls that are not fire protected located in the Main Mechanical Room. 3-Based on observations, the facility has not maintained the plumbing drainage in bathing areas in a safe manner by not complying with the North Carolina Plumbing Code. Findings on 07/13/2017: There is not a protective floor drain cover in the roll-in shower located in the Back Hall Shower Room. 4-Based on observations, the facility has not maintained the plumbing fixtures in the Bathrooms in a safe manner by not complying with the North Carolina Plumbing Code. Findings on 07/13/2017: There are loose toilet seats at the following locations: (a) Back Hall Shower Room (b) Room 1	C 189	Continued- 2) Maintenance will provide fire protection through the fire rated wall assemblies. 3) Maintenance shall oversee all electrical and HVAC piping to make sure it's all fire protected.
