Second interview with the MA on 06/04/25 at 3:04pm revealed: -Before he administered a medication to a resident, he always compared the eMAR to the medication bubble pack to ensure the resident would be receiving the correct medication. -He was not sure why he documented he administered Resident #1's gemtesa 75mg daily since it was not available. Interview with a second MA on 06/04/25 at 3:25pm revealed: -She administered medications to Resident #1 several times a month. -She did not realize Resident #1's gemtesa had not been delivered to the facility. -She thought she was probably "going too fast" during her medication pass and did not realize the gemtesa was never available for administration for Resident #1. Refer to interview with the Resident Care Coordinator (RCC) on 06/04/25 at 3:38pm. Telephone interview with the physician representative from Resident #1's physician office on 06/04/25 at 4:02pm revealed they were not made aware the gemtesa was not started on the day it was ordered. b. Review of Resident #1's May 2025 eMAR revealed: -There was an entry for vitamin D2 50,000-unit capsule weekly at 8:00am. -There was documentation vitamin D2 50,000-unit capsule was administered weekly at 8:00am on 05/05/25, 05/12/25, 05/19/25, and 05/26/25. Review of Resident #1's June 2025 eMAR revealed: -There was an entry for vitamin D2 50,000-unit capsule weekly at 8:00am. -There was documentation vitamin D2 50,000-unit capsule was administered at 8:00am on 06/02/25. Observation of Resident #1's medications on hand on 06/04/25 at 2:19pm revealed there was no vitamin D2 50,000-unit capsule available for administration. 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D 358	Continued From page 4 Telephone interview with a pharmacist with the facility's contracted pharmacy on 06/04/25 at 2:40pm revealed: -The facility last requested a refill for Resident #1's vitamin D2 50,000-unit capsules on 04/21/25. -The refill requested on 04/21/25 was enough to last until 05/21/25. -The facility would have a shortage of two doses based on the weekly vitamin D2 50,000-unit capsule dose. -Refer to interview with the Resident Care Coordinator (RCC) on 06/04/25 at 3:38pm. Telephone interview with Resident #1's Primary Care Provider (PCP) on 06/04/25 at 4:14pm was unsuccessful. Interview with the Resident Care Coordinator (RCC) on 06/04/25 at 3:38pm revealed: -The MAs were responsible for re-ordering medication a few days before the resident would be out of medication. -If a medication was not at the facility, she expected the MAs to call the pharmacy and ask when the medication would be delivered to the facility. -The MAs should inform her if there was a problem getting medication from the pharmacy so she could assist. -When removing medications from the medication cart for administration, the MAs were not comparing the label on the medication bubble pack to what was listed on the eMAR. 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D 367	Continued From page 5 10A NCAC 13F .1004 Medication Administration (j) The resident's medication administration record (MAR) shall be accurate and include the following: (1) resident's name; (2) name of the medication or treatment order; (3) strength and dosage or quantity of medication administered; (4) instructions for administering the medication or treatment; (5) reason or justification for the administration of medications or treatments as needed (PRN) and documenting the resulting effect on the resident; (6) date and time of administration; (7) documentation of any omission of medications or treatments and the reason for the omission, including refusals; and, (8) name or initials of the person administering the medication or treatment. If initials are used, a signature equivalent to those initials is to be documented and maintained with the medication administration record (MAR). This Rule is not met as evidenced by: Based on record reviews and interviews, the facility failed to accurately document the administration of medications on the electronic medication administration record (eMAR) for 1 of 3 sampled residents (Resident #1) related to a medication used to treat overactive bladder and a medication used for bone health.
