K 000	A recertification survey conducted on 06/30/2025 found Valley Senior Living on Columbia in compliance with the requirements of 483.73 Long-Term Care Facilities Emergency Preparedness. INITIAL COMMENTS This survey used the 2012 edition of NFPA 101, Life Safety Code, Chapter 19-Existing Health Care Occupancies and the 2012 edition of NFPA 99, Health Care Facilities Code in compliance with 42 CFR 483.70(a)(b). The facility was located in a one-story building of Type V (000) construction and a one-story building of Type V (111) construction. The building was protected throughout by an automatic fire sprinkler system designed to meet the requirements of NFPA 13, Standard for the Installation of Sprinkler Systems. A clinic was attached to the north side of the facility and was separated by an occupancy separation wall having a two-hour fire resistance rating. Note: Observation and records review determined the facility to be in compliance with the minimum requirements of the 2012 Life Safety Code and NFPA 99, Health Care Facilities Code.			K 000
