K 000	INITIAL COMMENTS This survey used the 2012 edition of NFPA 101, Life Safety Code, Chapter 19-Existing Health Care Occupancies and the 2012 edition of NFPA 99, Health Care Facilities Code in compliance with 42 CFR 483.70(a)(b). The facility was located in a four-story building of Type II (222) construction. One-story additions constructed in 1971 and 1974 were attached to the west wall of the original building. The 1971 addition was Type II (111) construction. The 1974 addition was Type II (000) construction. Other additions included a one-story activity area in 1982 of Type II (000) construction and a garage and van entrance in 1994 of Type II (000) construction. Attached to the 1982 activity addition was a Basic Care Facility of Type II (000) construction. The facility was protected with a wet automatic fire sprinkler system designed to meet the requirements of NFPA 13, Standard for Installation of Sprinkler Systems. Note: Observation and records review determined the facility to be in compliance with the minimum requirements of the 2012 Life Safety Code and NFPA 99.			K 000
